WHY DO I NEED TO SEE A PERIODONTIST? Your Dentist and Hygienist recommend that you see a Periodontist when gum disease begins causing bone loss or gum recession.

WHAT IS A PERIODONTIST? A Periodontist is a dental specialist that has had additional years of training to treat gum disease. Dr. Miyamoto attended U.S.C for her dental degree and post-graduate periodontal degree.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN AT MY FIRST VISIT? The Periodontist will complete a thorough examination of your mouth. The examination will be gentle, with little or no discomfort. She will then propose a plan to care for your mouth and will discuss her recommendations with your dentist.

DOES THIS MEAN SURGERY? Not necessarily. Our practice provides many treatment options depending on your specific situation and the severity of your problem. We prefer to use the least invasive, conservative, and most cost-effective manner. Non-surgical periodontal treatment is preferred, but does have its limitations. When it does not achieve periodontal health, localized surgery may be necessary. Modern surgical regenerative techniques seldom alter the appearance of teeth or cause significant discomfort.

WHEN WILL I RETURN TO SEE MY GENERAL DENTIST? We will work closely with your General Dentist. If crowns or fillings are needed, your dentist will provide them. You will return to your dentist for follow-up care after your periodontal treatment.
